We had a nice dinner and talked about our journey to Ireland and many other things about Irish culture.

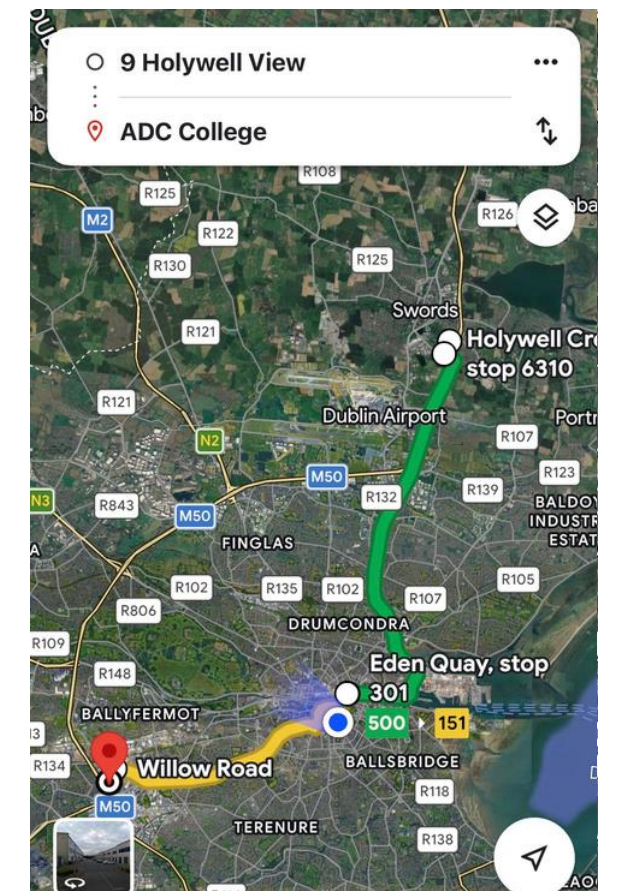
My first day in Ireland

FM ACCOUNTANTS



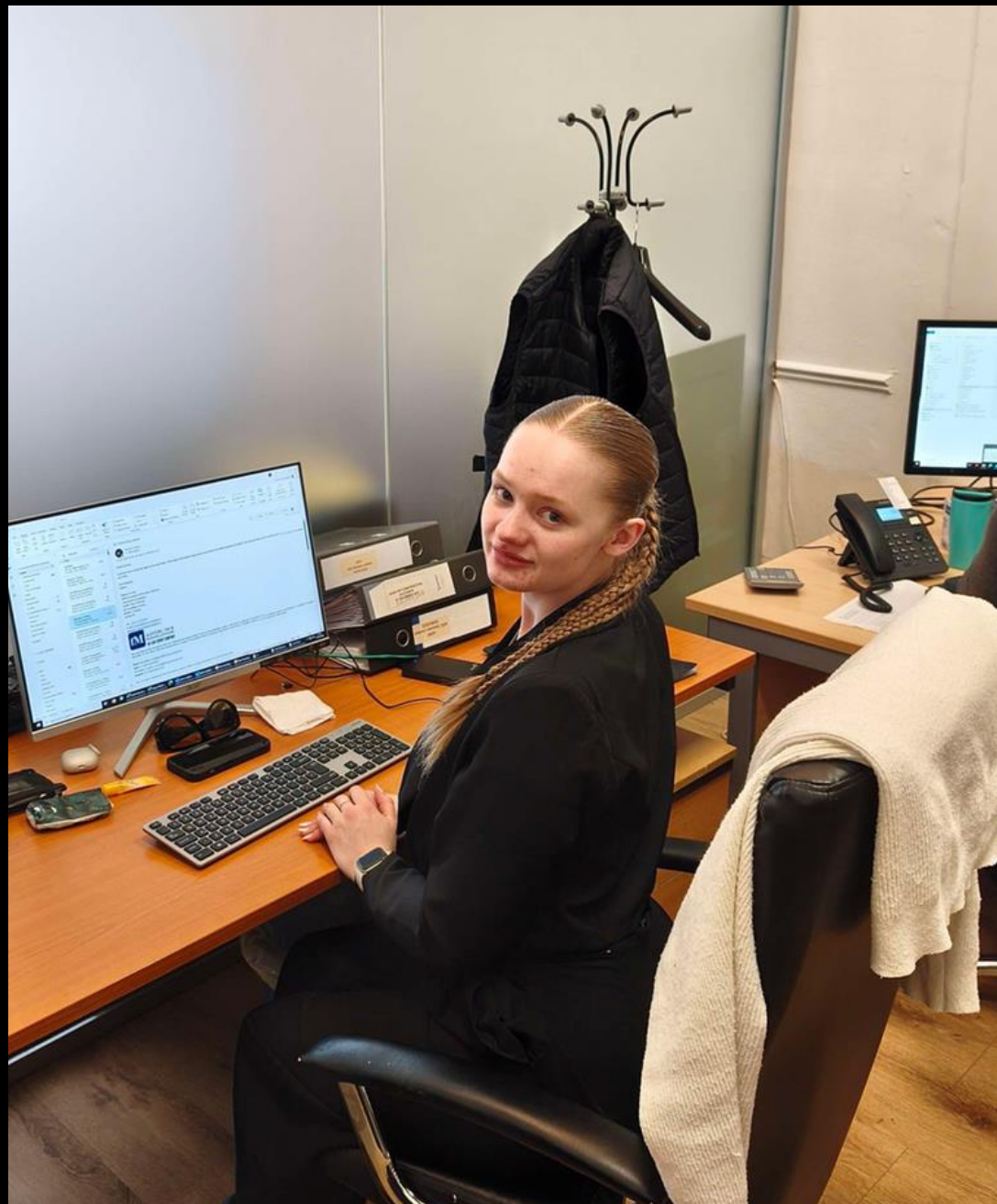

My first day was quite exciting for me from the point of new work life experience.

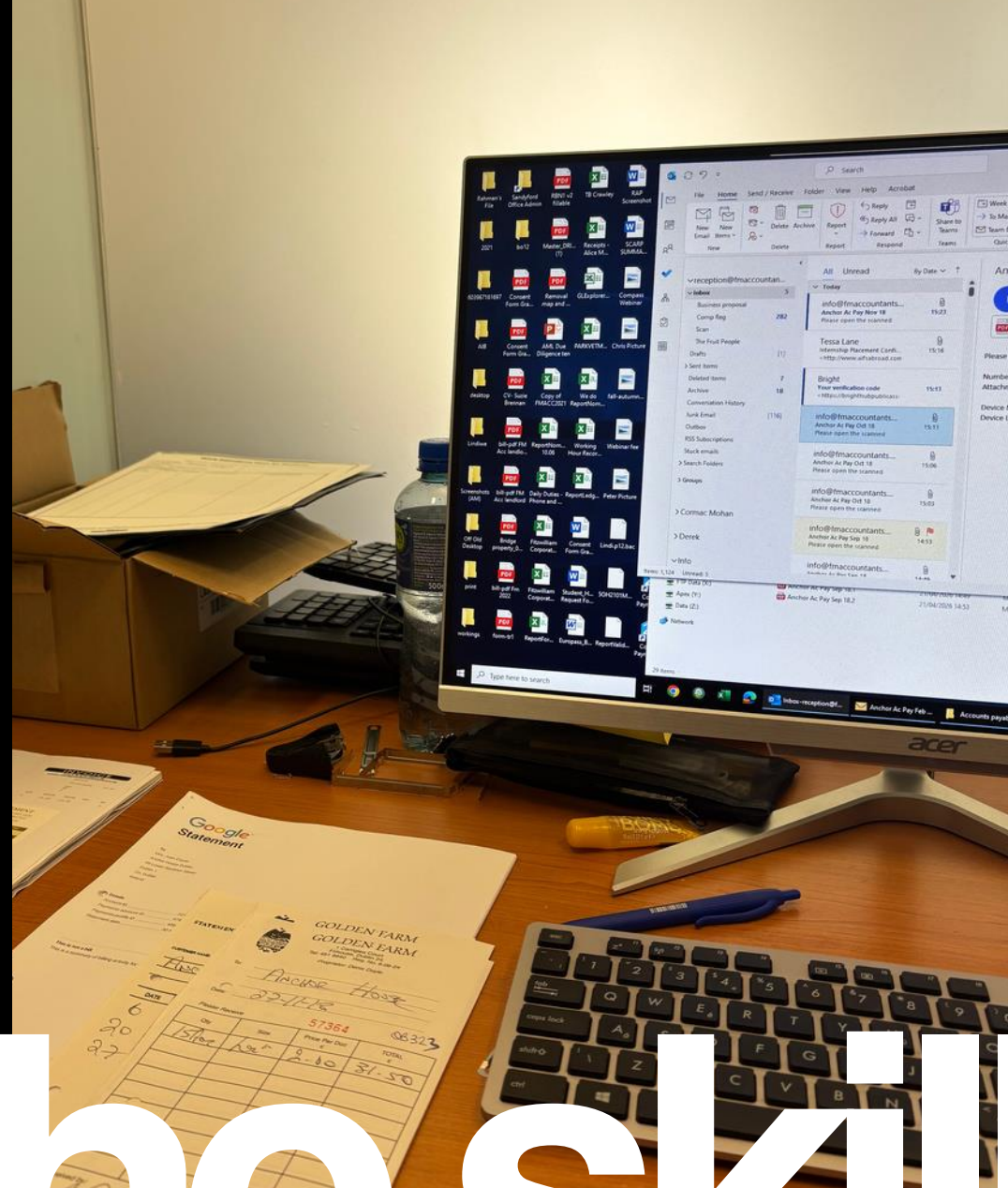


I managed to get on the place sooner to explore the location in the heart of Dublin.

The skills

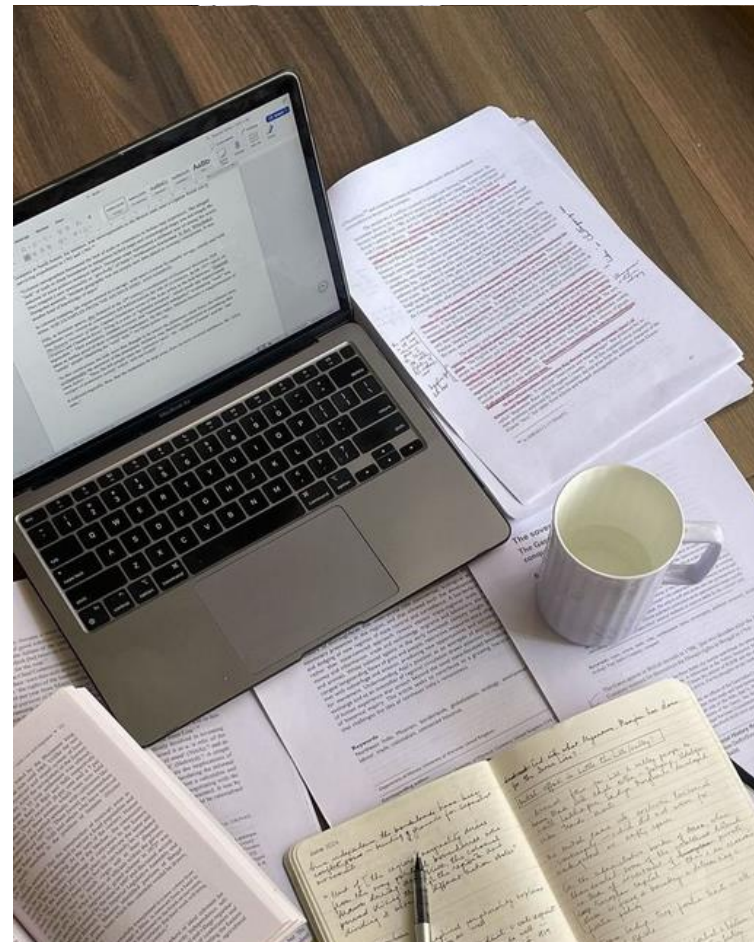

hasitate !

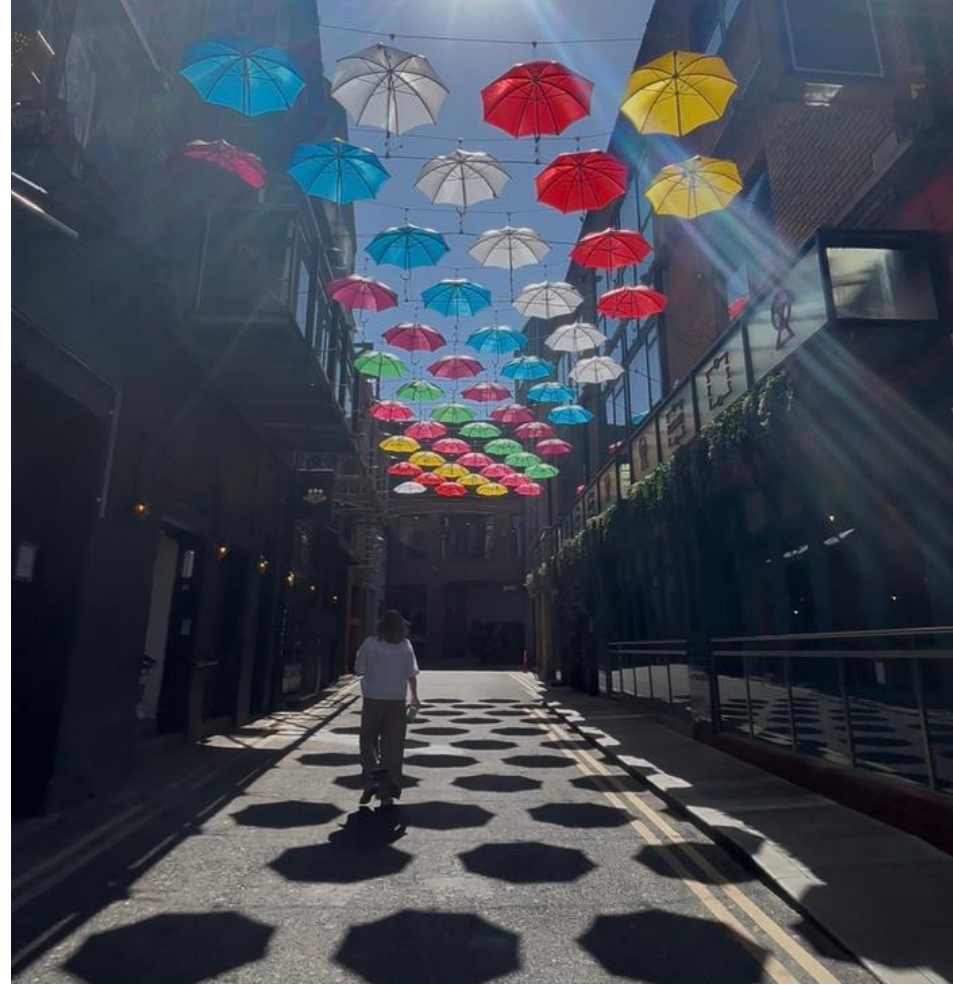


Although there were many
